

FIG.1 -- FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE




FIG.2 – PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT




FIG.3 -- TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS




FIG.4 – TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE
